

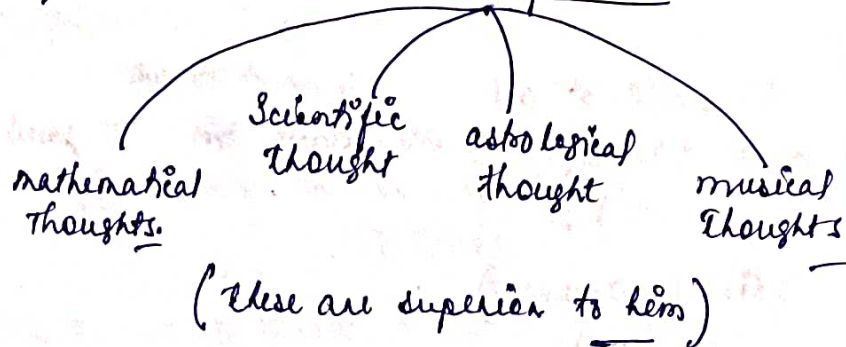
# Gulliver's Travels (Part III)

with soil not enough fertile to cultivate well.

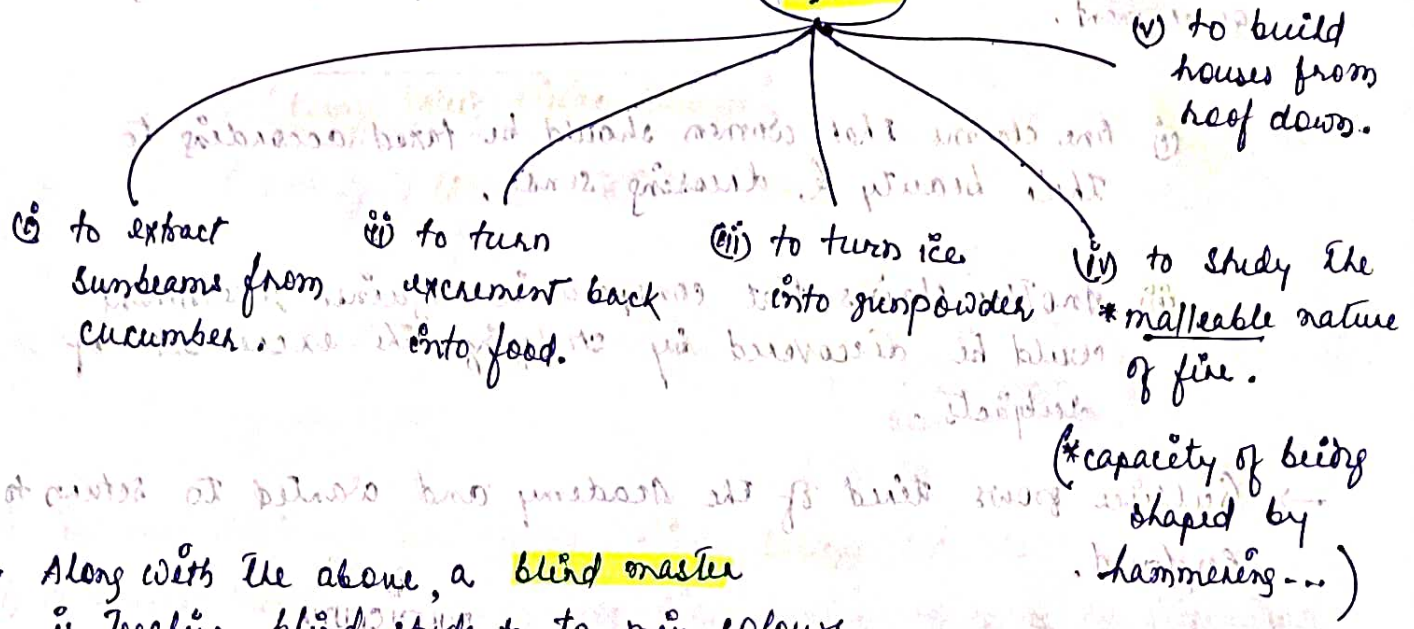
→ Then Munodi took him to the Academy in Lagado where some projects on science, Agriculture & technology were going on.
